The Sanctuary Hotel

Reflecting the style and charm of a grand southern seaside mansion, The Sanctuary at Kiawah Island Golf Resort is the crowning jewel for a resort island already known for its championship golf.

The 255-room hotel, enjoys sweeping views of the Atlantic Ocean, offers a private concierge level, two oceanfront restaurants, a casual seaside grill, martini bar, lobby lounge, three pools, more than 18,000 square feet of meeting space and a nature-based spa and fitness center.

Each spacious room features luxurious five fixture baths, large marble showers, dual vanities, private water closets, shuttered bathroom windows and ocean view balconies. An indoor pool with ocean view terrace and a Jacuzzi compliments the spa, along with a beauty salon, and a fitness center with the latest cardiovascular and resistance training equipment.

Turtle Point

Designed by Jack Nicklaus, Turtle Point features three spectacular oceanfront holes. Opened in 1981 and totally renovated in 2000, Turtle Point has a low profile design that takes advantage of the island's natural contours and dune ridges.

The course flows seamlessly through interior forests of hardwoods and palmettos, along backwater lagoons and finally to three spectacular holes along the Atlantic Ocean. Subtle greens

demand a keen eye and deft touch.

The course has hosted many amateur and professional tournaments including the 1990 PGA Cup Matches. It was recently awarded 4 ½ stars in Golf Digest's "Places to Play" reader's poll. Its \$7.5 million clubhouse opened in January 2001.



Cougar Point

Cougar Point is a great addition to Kiawah's collection of golf. Built on the site of the former Marsh Point Golf Course and redesigned by Gary Player in 1996 and a favorite of golfing guests. The par-72 layout features holes playing directly along broad expanses of tidal marsh, offering panoramic views of the Kiawah River and acres of needle rush and spartina grass. Cougar Point is designed to championship standards that will challenge the scratch player while providing an enjoyable round for all 18 holes. It was recently awarded 4 ½ stars in Golf Digest's "Places to Play."





Osprey Point

What began as a members-only golf course on the island noted for its playability has evolved into a championship-level course with a world-class layout that was completely renovated in 2014 under the direction of course architect Tom Fazio. Today's Osprey Point still delivers on its playability and natural beauty and gets rave reviews for its pristine conditions and elegant clubhouse.

Each hole on Osprey Point is unique and memorable—with four challenging par-3s, four extremely distinctive par-5s and ten outstanding par-4s ranging in length from 340 to 461 yards.



Ocean Course

Considered one of Pete Dye's best designs, the Ocean Course gained instant notoriety hosting the 1991 Ryder Cup Matches, as the site of the most dramatic "War by the Shore," a battle decided literally by the final putt of Sunday's final match.

Located on the eastern-most end of Kiawah Island, The Ocean Course has more seaside holes than any other course in the Northern Hemisphere – 10 right along the Atlantic.

Named as the third best course in Golf Magazine's "Top 100 you can play," this 7,937-yard course offers variable tee placements and spectacular views along two and one half miles of Atlantic Ocean.

The Spa

The Spa at The Sanctuary is a full service spa with traditional Southern hospitality. Kiawah's vast coastline and lush greenery were the inspiration behind several of our signature treatments. Time stands still as you heed the soft call of ocean waves and tinkling garden chimes, sink into your spa experience and then awaken in a soothing state surrounded by tranquil sounds and scents. Lowcountry features such as trickling water, gracious light, natural wood and rich slate impart the sense of a grand Southern porch and garden, traditionally a comfortable retreat for relaxing and reviving
